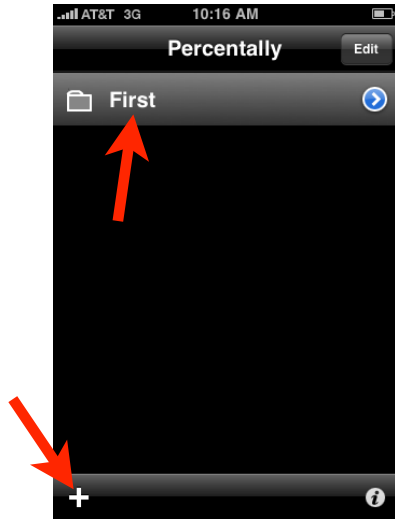

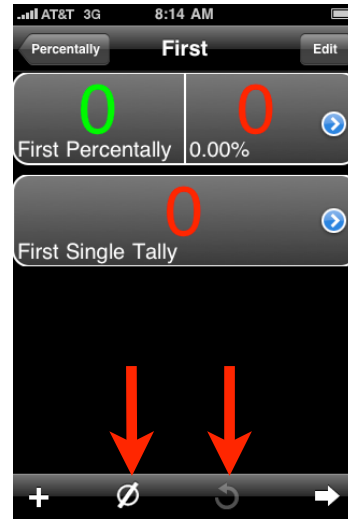

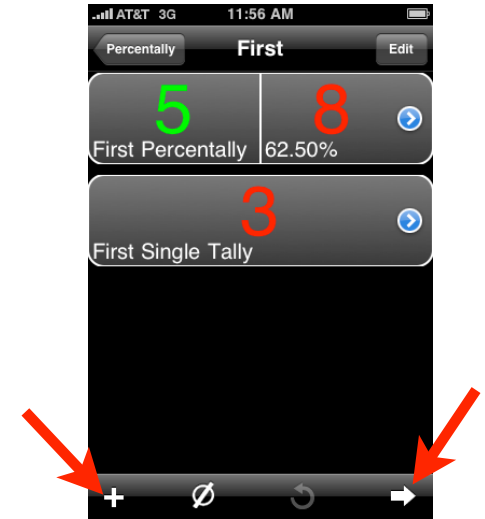
1) To add a folder, tap the **plus** icon. Insert a folder title, and tap **done**. Then, tap the **First** folder to begin tallying.



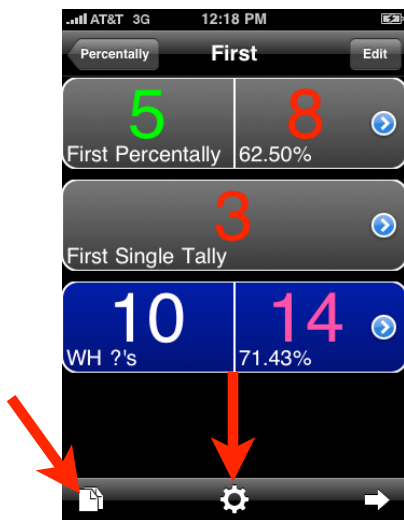
2) To collect data, tap the green number for successes, and the red number for total. Tap the **undo** icon to undo recent tally marks, and tap **reset** to zero the number(s).



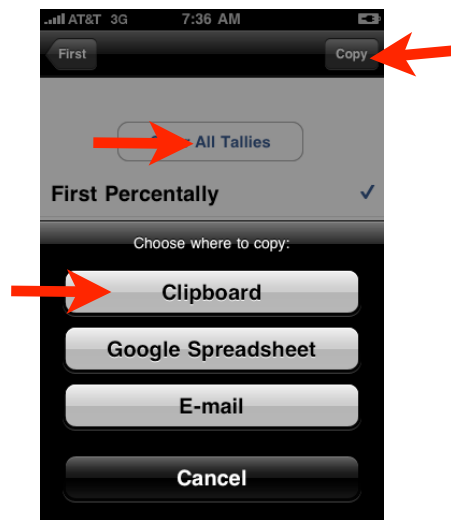
3) Tap the **plus** to create a percentally. Then, add a title, notes, and colors. Next, tap **done**. Tap the percentally success and total numbers several times. The percentage will be displayed. Then, tap the **white arrow** to view another toolbar.



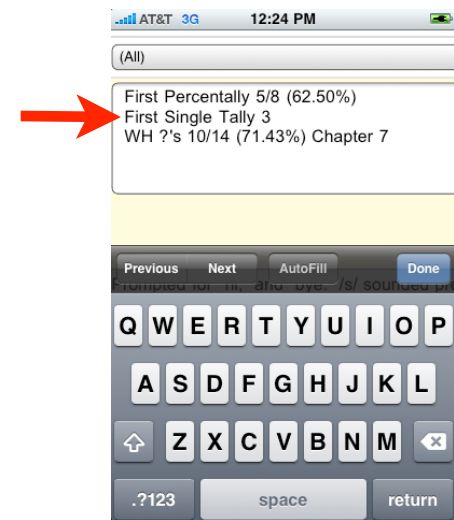
4) Tap **options** to configure the clicking sounds and tally colors. Choose **different** to achieve different clicking sounds for successes and attempts. And, choose the desirable default tally colors. Then, tap the **copy** icon.



5) Tap **Select All Tallies**, then tap **copy**. Tap **Clipboard**. Then, exit Percentally to access another application for pasting. Go to Google Docs in Safari, for example, to paste in an existing spreadsheet.



6) In a cell on the spreadsheet, double tap, and select **paste** to insert tally information. Exit Safari, and re-enter Percentally to resume tallying.
